<b>A -</b>	as in "Chicago"
<b>E -</b>	as in "Let"
<b>I -</b>	as in "Green"
<b>O -</b>	as in "Door"
<b>U -</b>	as in "Moot"
<b>Y -</b>	as in "Yes"
<b>EI -</b>	as in "Say"

<b>CH -</b>	as in "Loch" (gutteral kh)
<b>H -</b>	as in "Hi"
<b>G -</b>	as in "Gone"
<b>S -</b>	as in "Lesson"
<b>SH -</b>	as in "Shallow"
<b>R -</b>	Rolled/flipped always
<b>' -</b>	Shwa [ə] (before a consonant) or Glottal stroke (between two vowels)
